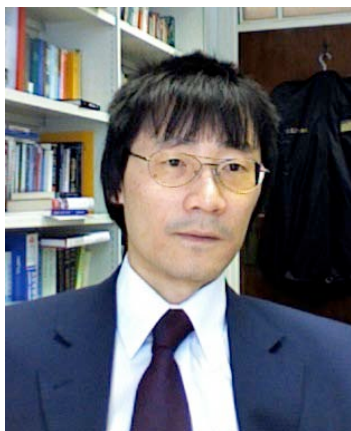
## East Asianists and the Job Market

He is the author of *The Politics of Economic Reform in South Korea: A Fragile Miracle* (London and New York: Routledge, 2000) His other publications include articles in journals such as *Political Studies*, *British Journal of Political Science*, *Economy & Society*, *Politics & Society*, *Review of International Political Economy*, *New Political Economy*, *Government and Opposition*, and *Modern Asian Studies*. He has also served as the Head of the Department of Politics & International Studies at SOAS (2006-10).
