Which requirements do I need to fulfill?

You need to hold a Bachelor degree (180 ECTS) or an equivalent university or college degree in an eligible major acquired at an authorized Austrian or foreign post-secondary educational institution. You can find examples of accepted Bachelor degrees in the <u>Curriculum</u>. English skills at an academic level are a basic requirement. However, there is currently no need to present any English certificates. Acquired East Asian language skills are no requirement for admission. What do I have to do for my admission?

- 1. The deadline for online registration for the program is February 5th. Please register here.
- 2. Please print and fill the application form and mail your duly signed application form and required documents. Please find the required documents for non- EU/EAA school leaving certificates here and for EU/EAA school leaving certificates here.
- 3. Note: The Admission procedure might take up to ten weeks. Therefore, please arrange enough time! Send in the application form and the required documents as soon as possible to make sure you get the acceptance letter before April 30th.
- 4. **Personal admission** with acceptance letter is possible until **April 30**th. You need to pay your tuition fee in the course of your personal admission. Please find more information on the amount of fees here. Please note that although the deadline for admission ends April 30th you should be admitted until the first days of March to make sure that you can register for courses (see below).

When can I register for courses?

Courses start in the first week of March. In order to successfully start your studies, it is therefore important that you are admitted as early as possible and that you obtain information about deadlines of enrollment and dates of courses. You can find all of our summer semester courses in our EcoS Course Outline. Only the section 15.04 A is relevant for EcoS student. Please do not bother about section 15.04 B. Besides information like title, type and content of classes, you can also find information concerning course lecturers, places and registration there.
