

# Position: University Assistant (post doc) in East Asian Politics

The position is at the [Chair of East Asian Economy and Society](#) in the Department of East Asian Studies.

Applicants from all subfields of **political science** whose research focuses on East Asia are encouraged to apply. The successful candidate will have a formal academic degree (either MA or PhD) in political science (including international relations and comparative politics) in addition to a formal academic degree in East Asian Studies. One of these degrees must be a PhD. Candidates with ABD will be considered.

The successful candidate must also have excellent command of written and spoken English and the proven ability to actively use one of the Northeast or Southeast Asian languages (no preference for any specific language) in his or her research at a very high level of proficiency. The successful candidate is expected to teach, among others, seminars on political systems in East Asia and on international relations in East Asia. This includes the professional supervision of academic term papers in these fields.
